



IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR WALKING-IN MARES 2016

Please contact the stud office to book your mare in.

No mare will be unloaded for covering unless the following paperwork is in place:

- A. A signed Nomination Agreement has been lodged with Gazeley Stud
- B. A fully completed and signed Mare Detail Form has been lodged with the Stud Office

The following documents must accompany the mare:

FIRST TIME OF COVERING

- 1) Passport or fully legible photocopy - to include passport number, microchip number, markings and vaccinations – equine influenza and tetanus must be up to date
- 2) Fully completed NSFA Freedom from Infection certificate
- 3) Negative Clitoral swab certificate
- 4) Negative Cervical / Endometrial swab certificate
- 5) Negative EVA test certificate
- 6) Negative EIA test certificate, including foals at foot for mares from Germany / Italy per NSFA regulations
- 7) Negative Dourine test certificate for mares from Italy
- 8) A Horserace Betting Levy Board or other National Approved breeding history certificate (CEM certificate) if not previously lodged with the Stud Office

SUBSEQUENT COVERS (except cross covers on the same oestrus (heat) period)

- 1) Negative Cervical / Endometrial swab certificate
- 2) Further negative EIA test certificate, if required, for mares from outside UK and Ireland
- 3) Passport or fully legible photocopy
- 4) Fully completed NSFA Freedom from Infection certificate

CROSS COVERS

- 1) Passport or fully legible photocopy
- 2) Fully completed NSFA Freedom from Infection certificate

ADDITIONAL NOTES

- Covering sessions are designated as 7am, 12 noon and 5pm
- Mares must have hind shoes removed or they will not be covered
- For mares arriving with foals at foot, a designated person accompanying the mare must be competent and experienced enough to adequately restrain the foal at a safe distance but within sight of the mare, and wear appropriate head and foot protection. The designated person must follow and abide by instructions given by stud staff, but no responsibility will be accepted for any injury to the designated person.
- Every care will be taken with your mare and foal but no responsibility whatever is accepted by Gazeley Stud for any accident, disease, injury or death whilst visiting Gazeley Stud.
- When requesting a cover, your mare will be booked for the earliest available cover on the date you have requested – whilst every effort will be made to accommodate requests for a cover at a particular session, we cannot guarantee that this will be possible. In addition, every effort will be made to accommodate cross covers, but they cannot be guaranteed at busy times
